AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE COMMITTEE ON ANTI-RED TAPE (CART) IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF GENERAL SANTOS CITY

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11032, otherwise known as the "Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018", mandates all government agencies to adopt simplified requirements and procedures that will reduce red tape and expedite business and non-business related transactions;

WHEREAS, the Anti-Red Tape Authority (ARTA) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-07, Series of 2020, directing all government offices to designate a Committee on Anti-Red Tape (CART) and providing the guidelines thereof;

WHEREAS, said circular instructs agencies with existing unit to comply with the Anti-Red Tape Act of 2007 (R.A. No. 9485), as amended by R.A. No. 11032, and should be reorganized as the CART;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LORELIE G. PACQUIAO, City Mayor of General Santos, by virtue of the power vested in me by law and the sovereign will of the people, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. CREATION. There shall be created a Committee on Anti-Red Tape (CART), which shall be composed of the following:

- Chairperson:** City Mayor or her duly designated representative
- Vice Chairperson:** City Legal Officer
- Members:** City Administrator
Department Head, City Treasurer's Office
Department Head, Human Resource Management and Development Office
Department Head, City Assessor's Office
Department Head, City Planning and Development Office
Department Head, Business Permits and Licenses Division
Department Head, Office of the Building Official

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The CART shall ensure compliance with the requirements of R.A. No. 11032, its implementing rules and regulations and subsequent issuances by the ARTA, as applicable.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The Human Resource Management and Development Office shall serve as the CART's Secretariat tasked to handle all administrative and secretarial activities.



SECTION 4. FUNDING AND OPERATING COSTS. All costs pertaining to the operations of the CART shall be chargeable against available funds and resources of the Local Government Unit of General Santos City, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, memoranda, rules and regulations, or any part(s) thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Order not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force and effect unless otherwise revoked or amended.
