



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01**

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE - LOCAL GOVERNANCE PROJECT (SGLG-LGPIM) IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING TEAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Seal of Good Local Governance Act of 2019 formalizes the system of awards, incentives, honors, and recognition-based programs for all LGUs to continuously advance and improve their performance in a range of governance-related areas;

**WHEREAS**, the SGLG seal is a means of recognizing good performance of cities and municipalities in the country, not only in Financial Administration and Sustainability but also in other governance areas that directly benefit the local citizens such as Disaster Preparedness, Social Protection and Sensitivity, Health Compliance and Responsiveness; Sustainable Education, Business Friendliness and Competitiveness; Safety, Peace and Order; Tourism, Heritage Development, Culture & Arts; Environmental Management and Youth Development;

**WHEREAS**, the city of General Santos is one of the recipients of the 2022 Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) among the 13 LGUs in Region XII who passed the SGLG National Assessment conducted in September 2021;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government granted the city of General Santos City an SGLG Incentive Fund amounting to SEVEN MILLION PESOS (P7,000,000.00) which will help the Local Government Unit of General Santos City to prioritize and fund projects to improve the lives of their constituents while instilling in them the values of transparency and good governance;

**WHEREAS**, a Local Governance Project Implementation and Monitoring Team (LGP-IM) shall be established to lead the implementation of the City of General Santos' approved SGLG Project and to oversee the implementation process from the time it begins to the time it is completed in 12 months from the date the SGLG Incentive Fund is received;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, LORELIE GERONIMO PACQUIAO**, City Mayor of General Santos, by virtue of the power vested in me by law and the sovereign will of the people, do hereby order:

**SECTION 1. THE COMPOSITION.** The SGLG – LGPIM shall be composed of the following team:

**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS.** The SGLG – LGPIM shall perform the following functions:

- a.) Provide up-to-date and relevant information on the over-all status of the implementation of the SGLG approved project from its commencement to completion phase;
- b.) Identify problems and issues which impede project implementation for remedial actions at the city level offices and elevate unresolved issues and problems at these levels to the Local Chief Executive for resolution and final actions;
- c.) Meet as often as necessary to discuss issues and concerns relative to the project implementation; and
- d.) Provide project completion report to the Local Chief Executive.

The Secretariat shall:

- a.) Prepare and disseminate periodic (monthly or quarterly) project monitoring reports to the Local Chief Executive on the status of project implementation as reviewed and approved by the SGLG-LGPIM Team;
- b.) Collate and make all pertinent documents available, relative to the identified SGLG approved project; and
- c.) Process and comply with necessary documents in the implementation of the project as may be required by the Department of the Interior and Local Government.

**SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATION SUPPORT.** Upon the effectiveness of this order, the SGLG-LGPIM Team may draw its administrative,



operational, and budgetary requirements from the available fund of the Office of the City Mayor.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All orders, memoranda, rules and regulations or any part/s thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this order are hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision thereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Order not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY.** This order shall take effect immediately.
